Leading north west architects Wilson Mason has been signed up by Liverpool Community College for its Design Services Framework.

The Framework, worth approximately £30m over three years, represents a programme of improvements to the Liverpool Community College estate.

The works include extensions, internal alterations and new build projects providing a new learner centre incorporating the 14 -18 year old student hub facilities, learning resource centre and sports academy. The existing Arts Centre remodelling will be carried out during the 2008 summer shutdown period.

Wilson Mason were appointed along with Austin-Smith:Lord and Ellis Williams Architects following a tender process.

Greg Musi, project architect at Wilson Mason, said: "This is an exciting programme of development that will build upon the existing high standards of the College. The proposals are set to create quality facilities that will be an inspiration to those who teach and learn within the College."

Liverpool Community College is the major provider of Further Education in Liverpool, delivering all Further Education curriculum areas from centres strategically located across the City.

The College is currently developing an accommodation strategy to address current and future capacity issues and expand the Colleges vocational facilities for 14 to 19 year olds. It is anticipated that the resulting Estate Development Programme will require design and construction of a number of new facilities and alterations to several existing facilities during the 2007 -2010 period.
